## Schedule

#### **Vegetable and Fruit Section**

In all cases the exhibit should be 3 items of one variety unless specified otherwise

- 1. Potatoes, red or white
- 2. Onions, globe or flat
- 3. Runner beans
- 4. Carrots
- 5. Courgettes (with stalks),
- 6. Tomatoes with stalks, not on the vine
- 7. Beetroot (3"/7.5 cm tops)
- 8. The most amusing vegetable (single)
- 9. Collection of any five vegetables (one of each variety)
- **10.** Collection of culinary herbs
- 11. Bowl of soft fruit
- 12. Bowl of any other type of edible fruit

### **Flowers / Floral Arrangement Section**

- **13.** A dinner table arrangement (up to 12"/30 cm high)
- 14. Single buttonhole with foliage
- **15.** Arrangement in a wine glass
- 16. Collection of garden flowers in a vase
- **17.** Five stems of sweet peas
- 18. A single rose
- **19. 3** dahlias, any variety

### **Cookery and Preserves Section**

- 20. Homemade preserves any 2 jars
- 21. 1 bottle homemade cordial / wine/beer/cider or flavoured spirit uncorked, with a glass
- 22. Five cheese scones
- 23. Five shortbread biscuits
- 24. Carrot cake, 7"/18 cm, round or square
- 25. Victoria sponge, up to 7"/18 cm round or square

## Special Section (12 years and under)

- 26. A model garden on a plate (max 12"/30 cm)
- 27. A painting or drawing of your pet
- 28. An animal created from one or more vegetables
- 29. The dandelion with the longest root

30. 3 cupcakes – your boldest recipe using any edible ingredients!
